Quality Hinges Since 1939

In the late 1980's, the Fraser government raised the idea and subsequent design competition for a 'New Parliament House' in Canberra. The final building design selected from the two-stage competition was the New York-based architectural company of Mitchell & Giurgola.

Many factors were considered by the architects for the new Parliament House, including the size and stunning grandeur, the relationship to the Burley Griffin master plan for the city within which it occupies the symbolic central area - known as the Parliamentary Triangle - was also a crucial factor. The new building was not designed to dominate the Canberran landscape, but rather be an intimate part of the view scape.

Being the major meeting point for the most influential people in he country, the standard of construction was specified to be of the highest quality, from its external environments through to the substructure and furnishings. McCallum Australia was chosen for the original installations and continues to be the selected supplier of Hinge Hardware for the thousands of doorways within the building.
